## Task 1: Symmetrical Shapes

- List all the shapes which are quadrilaterals and have 1 or more lines of symmetry.
- Draw all the listed quadrilaterals on a coloured paper or cardboard and cut each shape out.
- Draw the lines of symmetry on each quadrilateral.
- Fold along the lines of symmetry to check out your answers.



## Task 2: Let's Fly a Diamond

Resources: Tissue Paper

Straws

Glue


String

Scissors

Method:

- Draw a Diamond 50 cm long and 50 cm wide on your tissue paper.
- Cut it out and mark the shape's lines of symmetry.
- You can design and paint the diamond as you wish as long as it is kept symmetrical.
- Glue the straws along the lines of symmetry and along the border.
- Attach the string to the bottom of the kite.
- Attach a few bows to the string using the same tissue paper.
