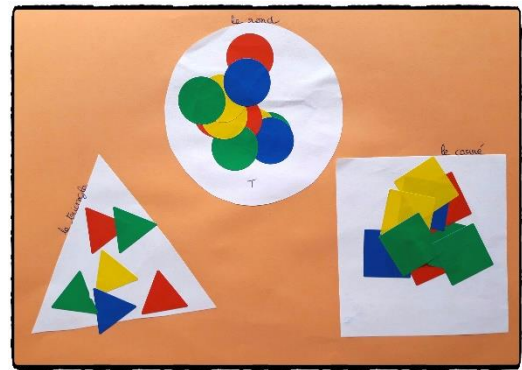


## 1) 2D Shapes Collage

Resources needed:

- Coloured cardboard paper
- Wrapping paper or any other recycled paper or cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue



Steps:

- a) Cut as many **squares, rectangles, circles and triangles** as possible from different wrapping papers.
- b) Cut these in different sizes, some **larger** than others and some **smaller**.
- c) Sort the **flat shapes** according to their names.
- d) Using the coloured cardboard, cut out a large **circle**, a large **rectangle**, a large **square** and a large **triangle**.
- e) Glue the sorted shapes on the correct coloured cardboard shape.
- f) You should have **2D shapes** collage.
